More about the program:

Concert of tones and colors is a nontraditional show in which two artistic worlds merge: music and fine art. The main protagonists – music composer and pianist Jiří Pazour and artist Olga Volfová – together create over the course of an evening artistic creations – piano and painting impressions. Both artists constantly inspire each other and so create music compositions and paintings that are related to each other. The paintings are inspired by just sounding music and vice versa. The show is largely based on improvisation of both artists. The painter creates art in real time in which the music sounds and in turn, the musician then improvises on her painting. This process gives rise to new works that are directly influenced by the current mood of both artists, selection of themes for the joint production, atmosphere in the hall, etc. In the second part of the evening, the artists improvise on themes suggested by the audience. The audience will learn the rules of improvisation in music and art, and will have the opportunity to closely observe the step by step creation of a painting on canvas, and see how the composition of music affects the emerging painting and vice versa.

Each evening is unique and unrepeatable, every time new music and art are created. These works, however, have a common subtext – inspiration by the artistic counterpart.
